

## The Cirdan Sailing Trust Sailing Schedule 2009

**Our sailing schedule is relatively flexible depending upon client demand. Over the years we have come to know where the majority of our groups like to sail and generally base the schedule around this. If you have a particular voyage project in mind for this season or for the future please put forward your proposal and we will be pleased to consider it.**

**Queen Galadriel** – generally sails on 7 day voyages but there are a limited number of 4 & 5 day and weekend voyages available during the season. Longer voyages can be arranged.

Sailings from Ipswich follow the River Orwell down to the busy container port of Felixstowe and the ferry port of Harwich before going out to sea or into the River Stour. Longer voyages can sail across to Holland or France.
