

Sailing Schedule 2010

Most of our voyage are for young people who experience some kind of disadvantage in their life. They come on board in groups with their leader/teachers/carers from youth organisations across the UK. We do run a small number of voyages for individuals – see below for details of Day Sails and voyages for young people undertaking their Duke of Edinburgh Gold Residential.

Our sailing schedule is relatively flexible depending upon client demand. Over the years we have come to know where the majority of our groups like to sail and generally base the schedule around this. If you have a particular voyage project in mind for this season or for the future please put forward your proposal and we will be pleased to consider it.

Queen Galadriel – generally sails on 7 day voyages but there are a limited number of 2, 4 & 5 day and weekend voyages available during the season. Longer voyages can be arranged.

Sailings from Ipswich follow the River Orwell down to the busy container port of Felixstowe and the ferry port of Harwich before going out to sea or into the River Stour.
